- The data generated were made possible by the entire health team and is intended to inform decision making policies using evidence based practices.

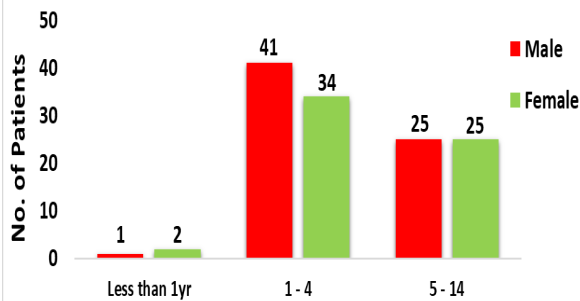

Communicable Disease Surveillance.

Outbreaks of Hand Foot and Mouth Disease (HFMD), Gastroenteritis (GE) and Fever & Respiratory Symptoms (ARI) were identified in the first quarter of 2025.

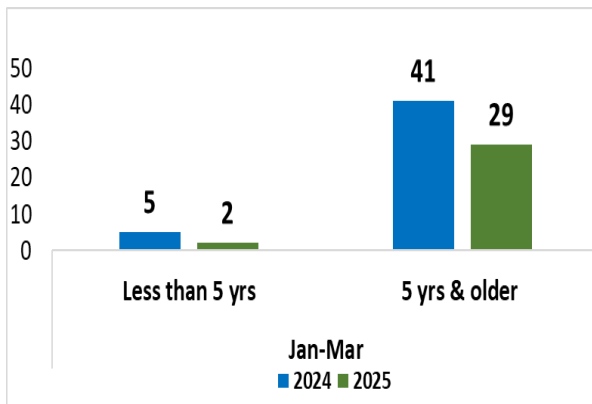
A total of 128 persons were treated (at both Public and Private Health Facilities) for HFMD. It clearly highlights that the **1-4 year** age group was the most affected across both genders.

A total of 31 persons were treated (mainly at Out- Patient Department) for GE and discharged.

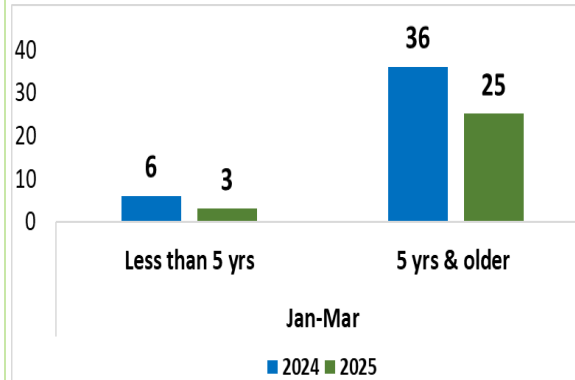
Graph Showing GE by Age Group 2024-2025

A total of 28 persons were treated (mainly at Out- Patient Department) for ARI and discharged.

For the period under review the following disease conditions were also reported:
